<b>Unhealthy</b>	<b>Everyone should limit time spent outdoors, avoid exercising outside (including sports teams) and choose non-strenuous indoor activities. Those with asthma, respiratory infection, diabetes, lung or heart disease, or have had a stroke should stay indoors as should infants, children, pregnant women and adults over age 65.</b>
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Areas around North Central Washington are receiving smoke from several local fires.

**Air Quality is expected to be in these ranges until Thursday.**

*Air quality will vary at times.*

Individuals with pre-existing heart and lung diseases, the elderly, children and infants are at highest risk of experiencing health complications from smoke. If you are in a sensitive group experiencing adverse health effects limit your outdoor activity or exertion level.
