Are there any precautions I should take when making/handling masks and gowns for others?

It is recommended that you wear a facemask yourself if you are making PPE for others. This may mean that you will wear the first mask that you make. Wearing a mask and thin cloth or latex gloves when handling masks for others is strongly recommended. Please honor the 6-foot social distancing when dropping off masks.
