No community COVID-19 testing available Dec. 23-27

East Wenatchee, WA – The Chelan-Douglas Health District will suspend its community COVID-19 testing Dec. 23-27 for the holiday break.

If you need a COVID-19 test, community testing is available through Dec. 22 in Mansfield at the Mansfield School District, 491 Road 14 NE, and in Wenatchee at the Town Toyota Center, 1300 Walla Walla Ave., and at the nonprofit organization CAFÉ, 766 S. Mission St. Times are available online at www.cdhd.wa.gov/covid-19/#freetesting.

The list of free drive-thru community testing sites is frequently updated on the CDHD website. Among the new testing sites added is CAFÉ, or the Community for the Advancement of Family Education. CAFÉ will be offering free testing Dec. 21-22 and Dec. 28-31. Testing is 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

After the Christmas weekend, new testing sites also will be at Cashmere High School, Peshastin-Dryden Elementary School, Market Place in Orondo and a walk-up testing site at Costco in East Wenatchee.

CDHD reminds the public that anyone can get tested at the community drive-thru sites; you do not need to be symptomatic or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19. Please be aware that positive test results can take up to 96 hours. Contact 509-886-6476 if you have questions regarding your test results.
